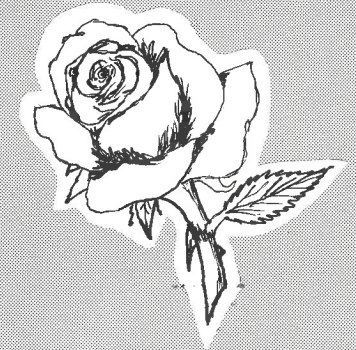
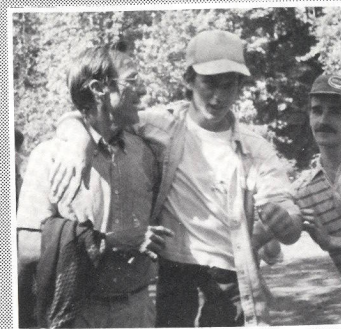
We dedicate this annual to you, Mr. and Mrs. Greer, for your many years of faithful commitment to this institution and the students.

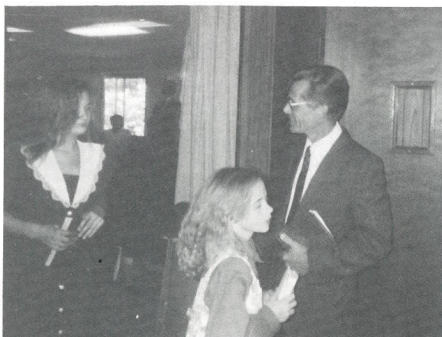

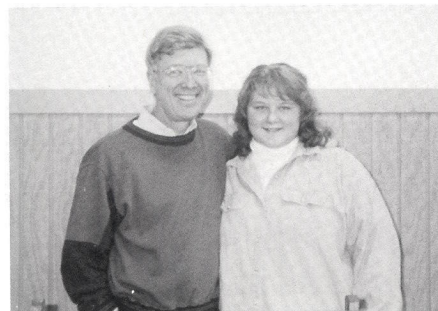

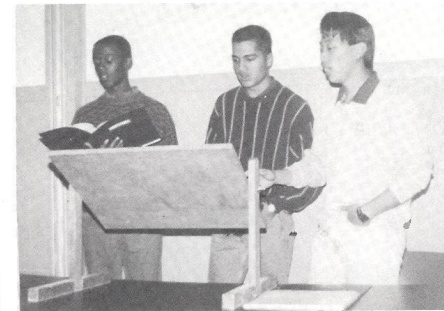

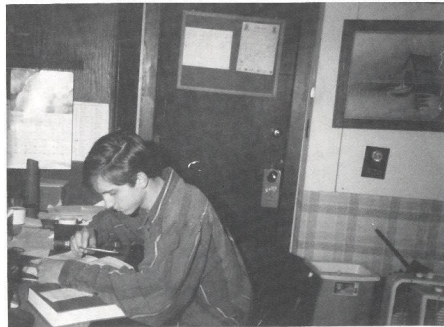

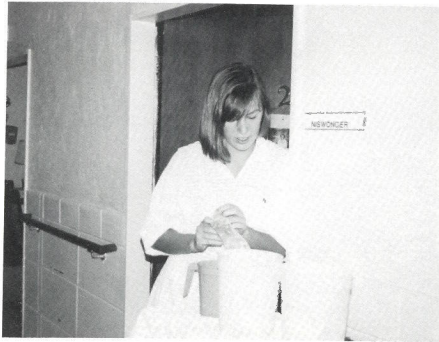
VOCATIONAL TRAINING



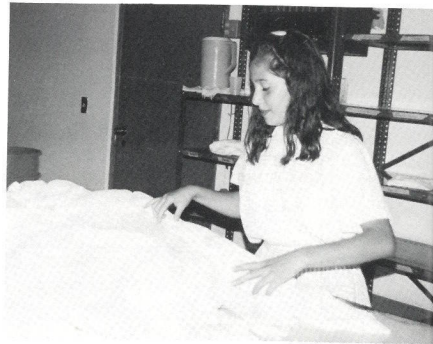

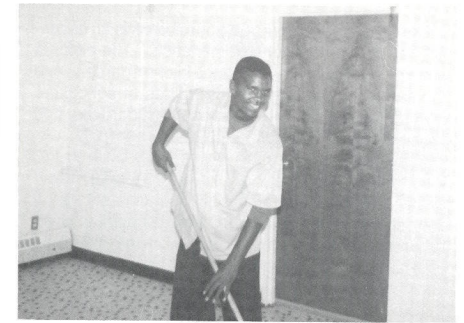

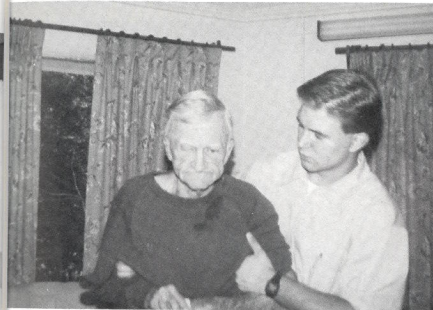

As Ellen White said in *The Madison School*, p. 33: "This training for Medical Missionary work is one of the grandest objects for which any school can be established."

AGRICULTURE

The agriculture program at Laurelbrook is an essential part of every student's experience. The pictures shown here depict the work in the kitchen gardens and the cannery, but there are other lines of agriculture work at Laurelbrook - field crops, truck gardens, and felling, planting, and cultivating trees - as well.

Mrs. White mentions in *Testimonies*, Vol. 6, p. 179 that "working the soil is one of the best kinds of employment." She further states that "study in agricultural lines should be the A, B, and C of the education given in our schools. This is the very first work that should be entered upon. Our schools should not depend upon imported produce, for grain and vegetables, and the fruits so essential to health. Our youth need an education in felling trees and tilling the soil as well as in literary lines."

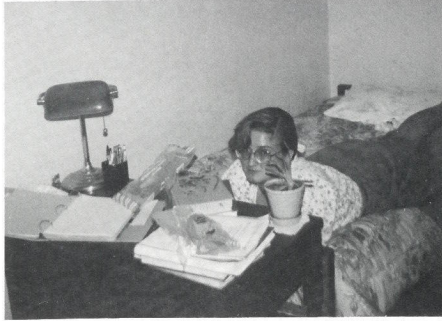
SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

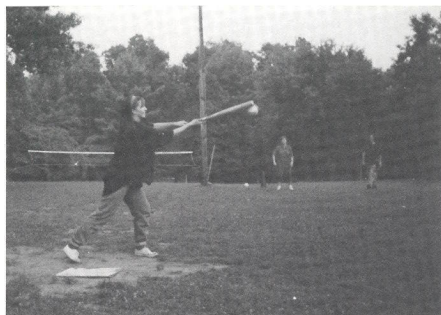
HIKES AND RECREATION

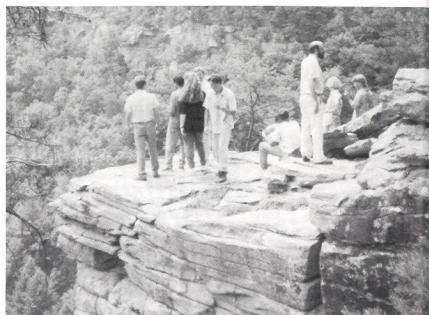
