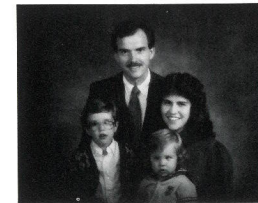
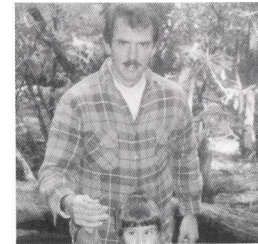
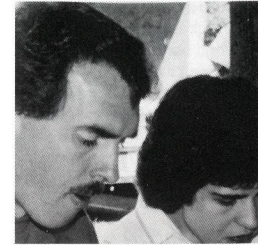
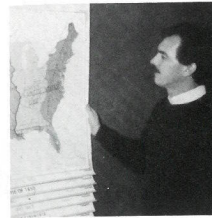
For your faithful years of support, devotion, and hard work on and for this campus, we dedicate this annual to you, Mr. Brian and Mrs. Joy Traxler.

WHAT LAURELBROOK MEANS TO ME

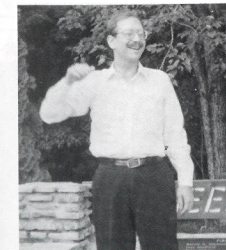
