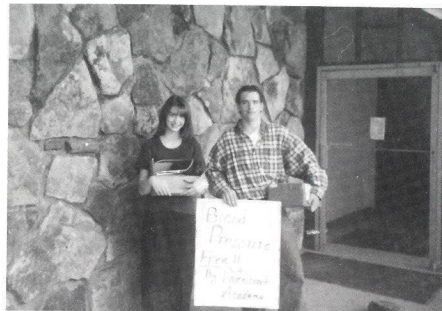

Mr. Baker teaches first aid to the junior girls.

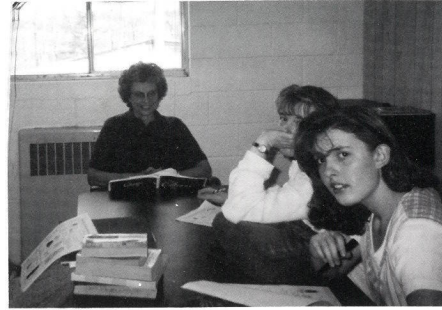
