



ames Brenneman moved his family of wife, 4-year-old son, and 7-year-old daughter to Laurelbrook Academy in the summer of 1983. During the course of his 37 years at Laurelbrook, he taught English 10 – 12, World history, American history, American government, and yearbook publishing. He was in charge of the campus grounds and trash collection for the institution for many of the years. He served God as well by enthusiastically leading out in song services, teaching Sabbath School classes for students and adults, being head deacon and leading in the audio-visual needs for the church, as well as the school. At Laurelbrook Academy, we believe school should be Three years at Laurelbrook will give you the opportunity about more than memorizing facts and reading textbooks. A true education prepares you for a life of usefulness and service. To give you this preparation, four hours of every school day are dedicated to both vocational training and life skills.

To ensure you get a chance to learn a variety of skills during your stay at Laurelbrook, students rotate through several areas of vocational training each year. By graduation, you will be able to say that you prepared entire meals, fixed cars in the body shop, and harvested plants in the greenhouses and garden. You may choose to become a CNA, a volunteer firefighter, or an auto mechanic. Vocational certificates are awarded for each vocational program you learn.







We help these young minds understand the real-world applications to becoming a firefighter. Teamwork, community outreach, and service are emphasized. Basic firefighting training with hands-on applications such as simulated car fires, search & rescue, and the proper use of tools, fire extinguishers, and prevention awareness gives each young person a real look at what is required to be a first responder. Upon completion of this program not only will each student have become certified in CPR but will also have the skill set, knowledge, and understanding every firefighter should have to begin their career. The goal is to instill a stronger sense of pride within their community, inspire new career choices, and spread the love of Christ through service."




















re you new to small engines and just don't know where to start? Then this is the class for you. We begin with an introduction to the Outdoor Power Equipment industry, which leads us to the necessity of today's small engine.

Four-cycle theory is the heart of what makes a small engine tick and is discussed in detail. This leads to the explanation of engine systems from A to Z including governors, carburetion, compression, ignition, and lubrication in detail and in a "hands-on" fashion wherever possible. We also cover proper fuel and oil requirements so that LBA students can properly maintain campus equipment.

Theory is strengthened through workshop labs. Two complete engine teardowns and reassemblies are performed. Small engine students learn the difference between "L-Head" and OHV style engines as well as vertical and horizontal configurations. A complete engine tear down and reassembly integrates the how-it-works with the why-it-works. Pay close attention, your engines must run upon reassembly!


